Code of Conduct for Students

The following are the acts and misconduct which amount to forbidden practices

- 1. Absence from classes without the permission of the teacher/Vice Principal/Principal.
- 2. Misbehavior towards teachers and any other employee of the school.
- 3. Disobeying lawful orders of the Teacher/Vice Principal/Principal.
- 4. Intentional disturbance of classes.
- 5. Bullying/Rowdyism and rude behavior
- 6. Eve-teasing/misbehavior towards girl-students.
- 7. Bringing unauthorized people/articles inside the school.
- 8. Bringing electronic gadgets, mobile phones, smart watches, etc. to the school.
- 9. Wearing jewellery, kadhas, earrings, chains, etc. (only 1mm kadha is allowed to Sikh students)
- 10. Bringing articles like expensive Watches, fancy items, expensive stationery, etc. to school.
- 11. Possession of or indulgence in smoking, drinking, consuming drugs or tobacco products.
- 12. Use motor vehicles like scooters/scooty/mopeds etc. by the students and bringing these in the school.
- 13. Use of drugs or intoxicants (except on prescription by a registered Medical Practitioner).
- 14. Any form of gambling.
- 15. Theft of school/students' property.
- 16. Disfiguring or otherwise damaging any school property.
- 17. Spitting in or near the school building except where the spitting is made in any spittoon provided by the school.
- 18. Use of violence in any form.
- 19. Casteism, communalism or the practice of untouchability.
- 20. Propagating a strike/disruption of classes, signature campaign or writing on the school uniform, in and around school premises.
- 21. Association with banned organizations.

All these above acts of misconduct are <u>forbidden practices</u>. In the above acts of misconduct, the Principal/HOS shall take suitable action as per the observation of the disciplinary committee at the school level <u>depending</u> <u>upon the gravity of the misconduct</u>, which may include:

- 1. Oral/written warning to the students and parents.
- 2. Detention during the break for Completion of neglected class work.
- 3. Suspension from attending classes/school for a specified period.
- 4. Recovery of loss through replacement of school property due to willful damage.
- 5. Expulsion/rustication from school for students of classes 9 to 12 in the rarest of rare cases.
