Work Education:

These students of Interact Club, Ecology Club, Debating & Journalism Club, Health & Wellness Club and Entrepreneurship Club have been working relentlessly. Students are senstized to work for the needy and less fortunate. Regular visits to old age homes & orphanages make the students count their blessings. Various donation drives are conducted on a regular basis. Students work to ensure that the school stays as a zero waste school.

Performing Arts:

Regular pursuit of visual & Performing Arts develops aesthetic sense

Students are exposed to a repertoire of music ranging from Indian folk, devotional, patriotic to classical songs. They learn about different singers and their genre.
