- Since the students suffered from certain disabilities, IEP or Individualized Education Program identified their ages, disabilities and abilities. Post this a special plan was customized for all students.





#### About LLC (Local Level Committee)

 LLC is a district level committee to provide guardianship for persons with autism, cerebral palsy, mental retardation and multiple disabilities, which is run under the aegis of Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment. From District Gautam Budh Nagar, The Ponty Chadha Foundation has been appointed as LLC NGO member.

#### **Guardianship under the National Trust Act**

 Under section 14 of the National Trust Act, the Local Level Committee headed by the District Collector is empowered to receive application in Form A under Rule 16(1) & appoint guardians in Form B under Rule 16(2) for persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation & Multiple Disabilities. It also provides mechanism for monitoring and protecting their interests including their properties.




