SCHOOL PROFILE

Don Bosco School Park Circus, Kolkata (DBPC) was founded in the year 1958 as a Secondary School for imparting quality education to students while nurturing them to become men of character, competence, sound conscience, compassion and commitment. The medium of instruction is English.

The school is affiliated to the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations (CISCE), New Delhi. The Council conducts two Public Examinations in March each year, one at the end of Grade X for which it awards the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (ICSE) and the other at the end of Grade XII for which it awards the Indian School Certificate (ISC).

DBPC has a Technical Institute which offers job oriented training courses and awards them with the following certificates: Industrial Training Institute (ITI) Exam, Don Bosco Technical School Diploma and the Certificate of Vocational Education (CVE) by CISCE, New Delhi.

DBPC goes out of the way to impart free education to hundreds of less-privileged children from the neighbourhood, through the Don Bosco Evening School and Adult Literacy Programme.

DBPC has also received The Telegraph School of the year Award several times. In fact, we are in the “Hall of Fame. It is on the sound education of the people that the security and destiny of every nation chiefly rests. This is precisely what is being done here at DBPC – imparting sound education by applying the time tested principles of Reason, Religion and Love propounded by Don Bosco, the great educator.

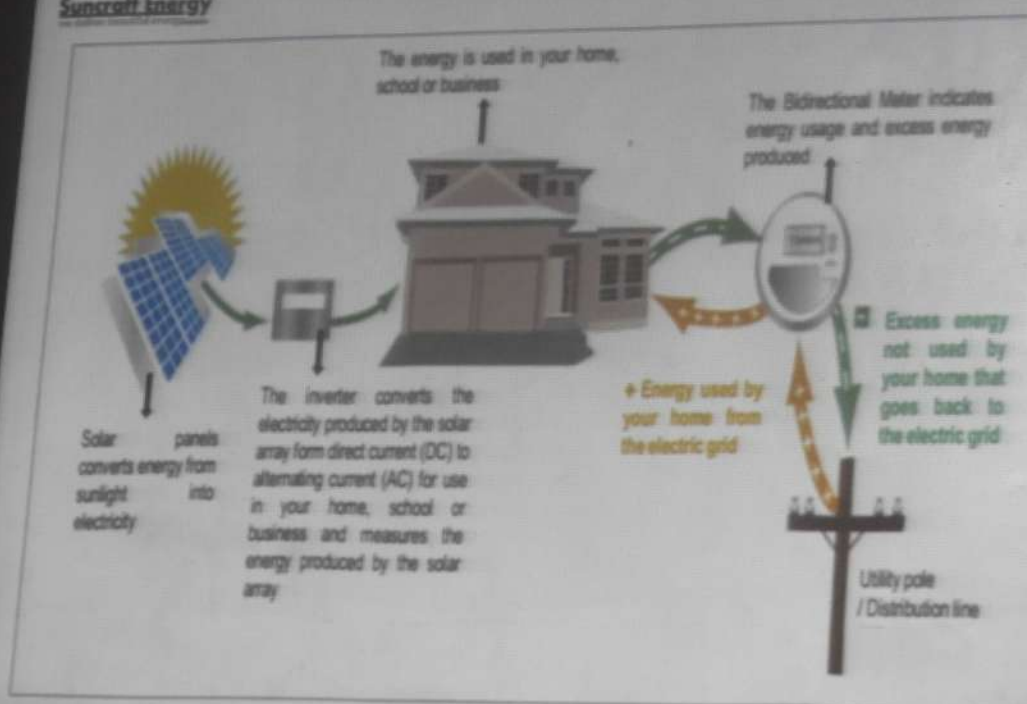
