Functional Academics and Activities of Daily Living (FA & ADL) Unit

Functional Academics is merely academics made functional. It is designed to teach skills which allow each student to navigate in real life situations at home, school, at work and in the community.

Each child is unique and special. We focus on an Individualized Educational Program (IEP) according to the need of the child. We use lot of TLMs, Multi sensory aids, computer and calculator. Training is mainly through class room interaction. The curriculum includes areas of a more practical nature necessary for day to day living such as reading, writing, number concept, money value, time concept, communication skills receptive and expressive language, social skills and training for motor skills.

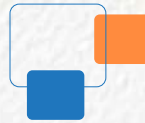
We focus on eight domains.



Realizing the importance of activities of daily living, they are made main part of the everyday curriculum -Self -Help Skills such as eating, toileting, grooming and maintaining hygiene are focus areas. Top priority is given to help children become independent in self help skills. The child learns the basic etiquettes and mannerism to interact with the society they live in.

Guidelines For ADL Training:

- Use of real objects
- Collect all relevant materials before starting any activity
- Follow simple rules
- Provide all relevant information about related materials of that activity
- Ensure safety rules
- Create friendly atmosphere
- Proper observation and provide suggestion as per need during training
- Provide positive feedback, after successful completion of task

Vocational Training (VoC Lab)

Vocational training prepares the students to be gainfully employed in a sheltered environment. Training is given in the following areas :

1. Candles Making- Decorative and Gel Candles
2. Diya making
3. Soap Making
4. Gardening
5. Making Greeting cards
6. Door mat weaving
7. Jewellery Making
8. Bag Making - Paper and Cloth
9. Home decor items.

The goal is to develop a sense of responsibility, deference to authority, understanding instruction and a basic work ethic. Underlying goal of all skill development is developing a sense of self worth and dignity as a member of the community.

Guidelines for Vocational Training:

- **Preparation:** Keeping all the items ready
- Instruction to the students, to wear the apron to operate the stove (on and off), Measurement of wax, to know the quantity to melt and add, threading mould, to pour it in the mould and set the time, to dry for some time and finishing the candle.
- **Settlement:** Placing items and cleaning the place
- **Finishing:** Packing and labelling.

The joy on seeing their creation is a sight to behold. Vocational training is all about learning by doing.
