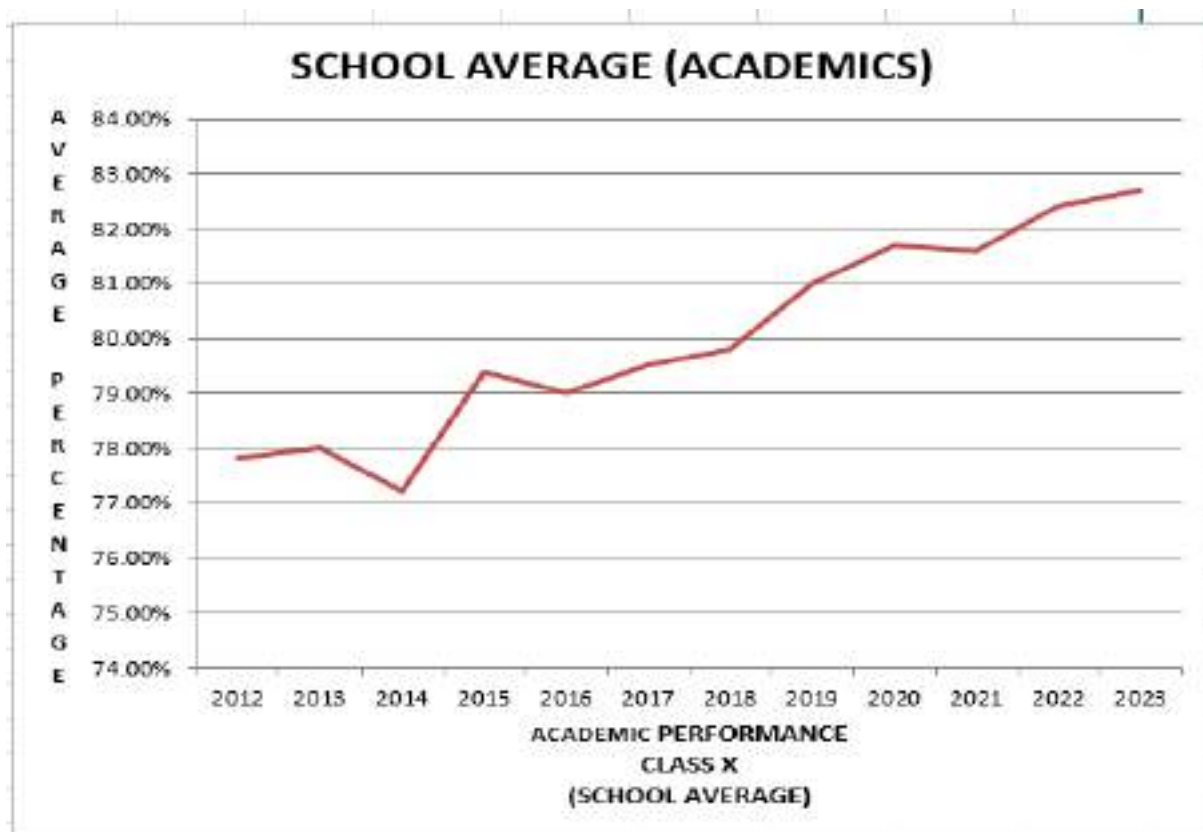
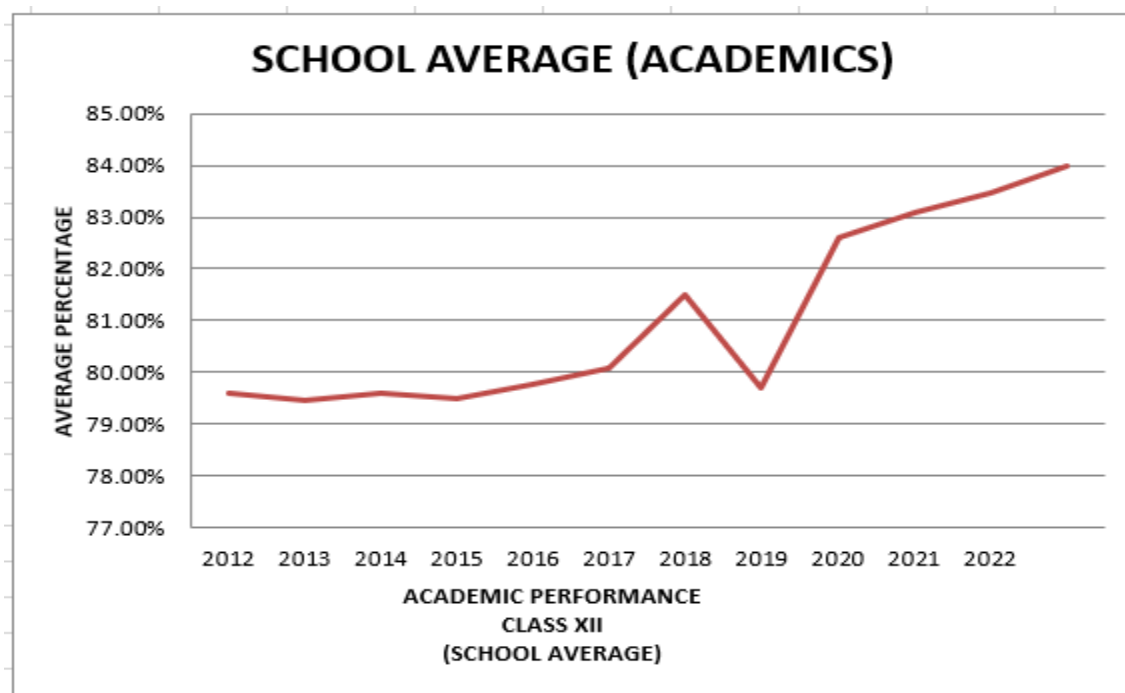

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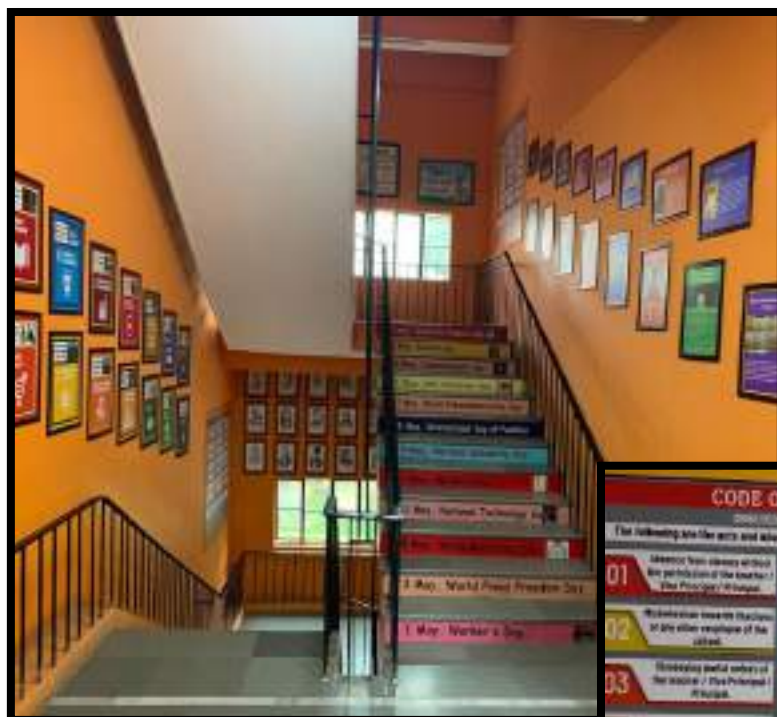

The following are the acts and misbehavior which are subject to forbidden practices		
01 Absence from classes without the permission of the teacher / The Principal / Warden.	08 It is prohibited to display mobile phones in the school.	15 Theft / pilferage of school / students property.
02 Misbehavior towards the staff of the other employee of the school.	09 Smoking in any of school building.	16 Disobeying or obstructing any staff or work project.
03 Disobeying school orders of the teacher / The Principal / Warden.	10 Any behavior obstructing of a student.	17 Bullying or sexual harassment or any other behavior that is against the school policy.
04 Intentional disturbance of classes.	11 Drinking / chewing gutika / Pan-Khane etc.	18 Use of violence in any form.
05 Bullying / Harassment or a rude behavior.	12 Use of motor vehicle like scooter, motorcycle, by the student and bringing them to the school.	19 Excessive participation in games or sports or other activities.
06 Involvement in misbehavior towards staff students.	13 Use of vulgar or obscene language or profanity by a student or staff member.	20 Propagating a strike / demonstration in classes.
07 Unauthorized possession of the school.	14 Any form of gambling.	21 Dealing with harmful substances.

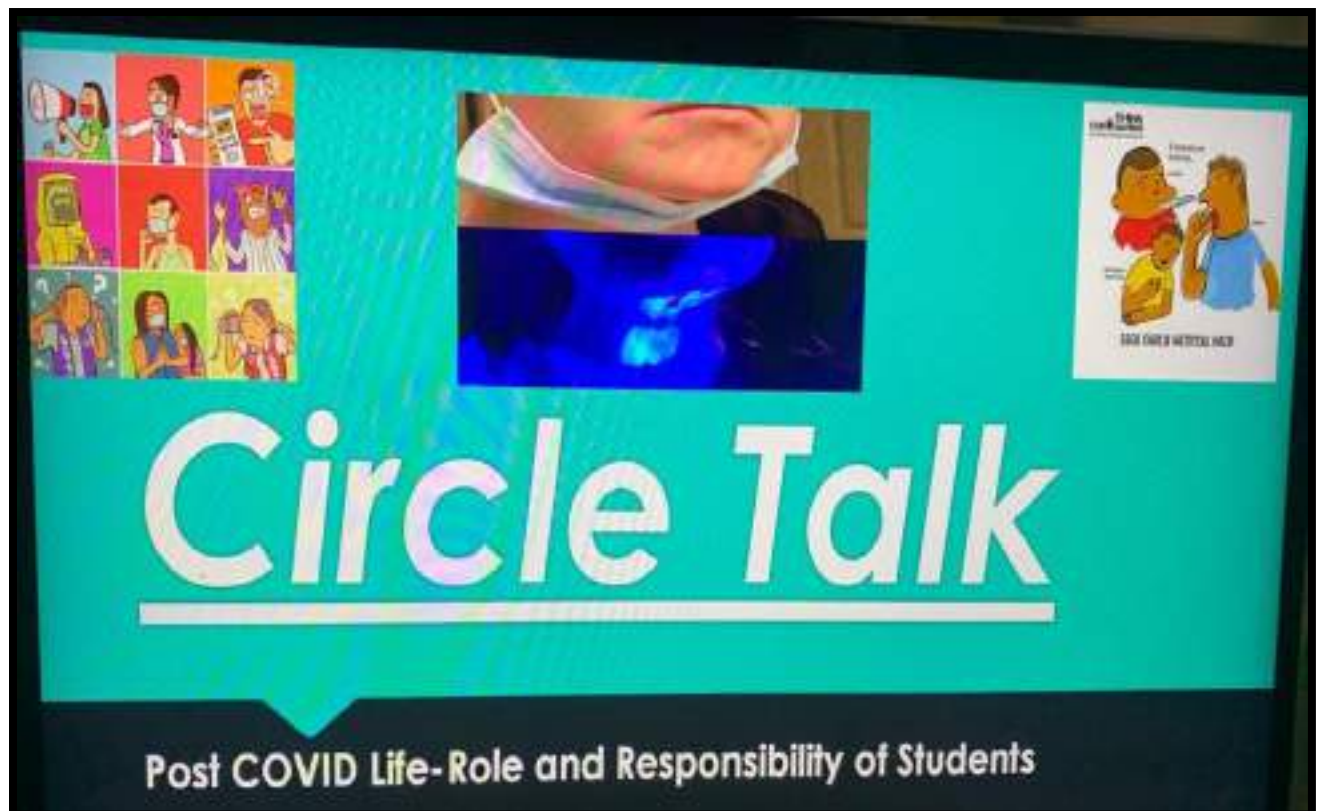
- Warning to the students and parents.
