ACADEMICS

With glory and laurels, OPJS family has been graced to corner a huge share of overwhelming admiration from parents and public in the wake of outstanding scholastic achievements of our brilliant learners in Class-X and XII (both Science & Commerce stream) CBSE Board Exams 2022. To reckon with, among the toppers from Class-XII Science stream stand out Sohum Sahoo (98.20%), Shruti Das (95.20%), Jahnavi Priyadarsini (95.20%) Ashish Pradhan (94.6%) and from Class-XII Commerce are Khushi Varma (88.20%) and Ananya Sharma (85.20%). Similarly with the school average 80.75% in Class-X exam among the Class-X achievers are Prerana Bothra (98.8%), Abhilipsa Pattnaik (98%) and Riya (96.8%) who brought laurels to the institution and were felicitated by the Chairman of the school management committee and Executive Director of JSP, Odisha as well as the Principal of the school for their remarkable achievement in the Board Exam. To the great glory of the school 100 out of 100 marks were retained by 6 scholars in Sanskrit, one in Mathematics and one in Science in AISSE (Class-X) Board exam 2022.

In addition to these top scorers, the overall performance and sweeping success of the school with 100% percent pass rate in all CBSE exams distinguished the institution from its parallel concerns in the reasons. The school with its outstanding results amidst oncoming impediments owing to adverse effects of Covid-19 pandemic has retained its excellence producing brilliant scholars who have qualified the national Level Entrance and got admitted in renowned medical institute like AIIMS, Guwahati and IIT Delhi, Varanasi, Bhubaneswar, NIT-Rourkela, VIT, VSSIT, Sambalpur, Christ University, Bangalore, XIM University, Bhubaneswar; Trident Academy of Technology; IGIT Sarang (Dhenkanal); KIIT & KIIMS Bhubaneswar; OUTR, Bhubaneswar, ICFAI Hyderabad; O.P. Jindal Global University, Raigarh to our great glory.

As to CCA records, the school has always emerged to its glorious pinnacle snatching the coveted awards and medals with outstanding performance at district, state, national and international level.

To begin with, participating in the Sahodaya Schools complex, Bhubaneswar Chapter Odia Debate 2022, G. Shakti (IX-A), stood 1st in the whole region and brought great laurels to the school.

At OPJS inter-school competitions 2022 held at OPJS, Raigarh on the occasion of Founder's Day 8 scholars of OPJS, Angul including two teachers, snatched the covetous awards in 1st, 2nd and 3rd positions in Debate, Song, Art & Painting, Essay Writing, English and Hindi poetry writing and Web-designing competitions.

At State Level Dance competition Biswa Bangla Mega Dance Festival held at Puri in October 2022, four students of OPJS bagged the prizes with trophy at Cultural Development Foundation 'Urvashi', held at Puri; eleven participants got awarded at Nrutya Sagar-2022 held at Digha all the 11 young artists brought laurels to the school including their glorious achievements in the Dance Competition 'Puaravi' held at Kolkata in November 2022. Similarly, Satchentan Satpathy (VIII-A) and Dristi Debangan won the district level 'SatKosia Dance Festival' Competition held at Angul.

To reckon with achievements of our scholars in Song and Music, OPJS scholars had exhibited best of their skills and talent at Inter-School Group Song Competition held at OPJS, Raigarh (CG) on Babuji's Birthday and won 2nd

position; at district level Gosala Song Competition held at Angul and Zonal Level Kala Utsav, Cuttack held at Cuttack won 1st & 2nd in both song and instrumental. Both Swapnil and Akash Dash secured 1st position and qualified themselves for the National Level Song Competition. To add further, in 2022 Poorva Kumari and Aseem Dhal in Senior Group bagged the 1st and 3rd prizes at the Independence Day District Level Solo Song competition held at Angul. Ritika Nair (IX-B) stood 1st in English extempore speech at district level Jambori and Anisha sahoo (X-B) stood 2nd at the fashion show held at Jarasingha, Angul.

On 18th June 2022 a total of 13 students representing OPJS Bharat Scouts and Guides bagged Rajya Puraskar Award by His Excellency Mr. Ganeshi Lal, the Governor of Odisha.

The list is long to enumerate the sterling achievements of our learners in Art and Painting competitions held in 2022-23. The star artist of the school Astha Aditi Sahoo (VII-A) & Ananya Anwesha Dehury (X-B) stood 1st in Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Painting Competition held on 27th July; Stamp Designing conducted by Govt. of India Postal Department in August; Inter-School Painting held at OPJS, Raigarh on 6th August; Matru Shakti Goraksha Samiti, Angul; District Level Utkal Kala Sanskruti Pratisthan; National Child Art Contest at Kalahandi; The Times of India Sit & Draw Painting (Jr. Group); State Level Painting conducted by Child Welfare, Bhubaneswar (OSCCW). Similarly among other young prodigies of OPJS are Tanash Adhikari (XII); Dibyana Dibyansha Dehury (VII-B); Sunayana Veshya (III-A); Satchetan Satapathy (VIII-A); Ananya Anwesha Dehury (X-B); Vishaka Naik (IX-A); Riya Dutta (IX-A), Tritikshya Bal (VIII-A); Shreyansh Suryam Pradhan (VII-C); Kabya jatua (VIII-B); Ananya Das (V-B); Ranak Kumar Ghosh (VII-A) & Snakalp Soumyajeet Meher (IV-B) who brought laurels and high acclaims to the school in all the above said competitions by virtue of their rare god-gifted talent in Art and painting.

Another popular co-scholastic aspect adding feathers of glory to the institutions that comes under CCA recounts remarkable achievements of our blooming buds. As per CCA records 2022-23, 95% students of the school have been associated

with Skit, Drama, Poster-Making, Pot-Making, Debate, Dance, Speech, Music, Art & Painting and so on and a total of 400 prizes under 121 competitions in the stream Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, Veer Gatha and Budding Authors as initiated and sponsored by CBSE, New Delhi have been felicitated with trophies and certificates of excellence to their glory during the session 2022-23.

The school also feels proud of its glorious achievements awarded to the staff members during the session. Dr Mohan Sundar Meher, TGT English, and Dr Imran Perwaiz, TGT Sanskrit were respectively awarded 1st prize in English poetry Writing and Hindi poetry Writing competitions on the occasion of Founder's Day 2022. Mr. Ramesh Kumar Panda glorified the school winning TATA Class-Edge Championship-02022 Trophy & Certificate for his excellence in Class-Edge usage in the whole east zone of Odisha. Mr. Raj Kumar Nahak, the ever acclaimed choreographer of the school was awarded 'Guru Ratna Award' 2022.

As to sports playing a significant part in the teaching-learning process, our school participated in East Zone Boxing Championship 2022 (Cluster-1 & 2) organised by Guru Tegh Bahadur Public school. Under 17 boys Rudra Jetwa (VIII-B) won silver medal with 2nd position at Kolkata, West Bangal. At State Level CBSE Cluster Athletic Meet 2022 held at Bilaspur, out of 21 participants both Junior and Senior from our school, we secured 5 silver under 14 Girls category and 5 Silver under 14 boys category. Further at Bharani, Bilashpur organised by St. Xavier High School, Bilaspur under17 boy Javelin Throw, Satyajeet (XI-Science) won bronze medal whereas under 14 girls, Shrabantika Chhotray (VIII-B) snatched bronze medal in shot put and brought laurels to the school. As to our flamboyant Annual Sports 2023, kudos to all young athletes, teaches and staff for successfully organising the 10th Annual Athletic Meet at G-1 Sports Ground on 19th January in the august presence of Mr. Damodar Mittal, ED, JSP Odisha who graced the occasion as the Chief Guest. With as many as 33 athletic events accompanied by welcome dance, Pragya House was adjusted House Champion at the meet followed by Prerana and Pragati House as 'Runners-Up'.

With the motto research, innovate and empower, the school feels fortunate to have introduced Micro teaching Classes in a series of Workshop from 29th April 2022 to 12th May 2022 under which almost all the teaches were covered, each having made their best presentation in topics like Active Learning, Developing Memory and Concentration, Overcoming Anger, Good Manners and Etiquettes, Attitude determines the Altitude, Thinking Skills, Multiple Intelligence, Quality Teaching, Learning Styles and Personality: Creating Lasting Impression and so on. Teachers of O.P. Jindal school to be equipped with resources and latest technical as well as pedagogical skills attended scores of webinars sponsored by CBSE round the year and many have achieved their Teachers Training Certificate undergoing Training Online under Centre of Excellence for CBSE New Delhi.

As regards the achievement of learners, out of 192 registered students in IEO 9 students from Class-III to XII have qualified level-II; 289 registered in IMO; 191 in NSO; 43 in NCO; 18 in International Commerce Olympiad with a total number of 21 Gold Medals and a Cash prize secured by 3 brilliant scholars of OPjS.

The school has also registered as many as 79 students under Silver Zone Olympiad and all of the scholars have successfully appeared in the Olympiad exam in 2022-23.

The school is also proud of having registered Junior Division Boys NCC Troop 1, under Odisha Air Wing Squadron NCC, Bhubaneswar with a total strength of 100 NCC Cadets; and for Jr Wing Girls that started since 2018-19, we have 125 Girls Cadets in fold under Unit 2 Odisha, Dhenkanal Division and 18 Cadets have secured 'A' certificates to their credit.

O.P. Jindal school has also the proud privilege to represent Sahodaya Cluster level Science Exhibition 2022 held at Army School, Bhubaneswar during the session. At the Inter-School Science Exhibition 'Innovision' 2022, first of its kind, organised by O.P. Jindal School on 19th November. There were as many as 23 exhibits on themes like Environmental Issues, Biodiversity conservation and sustenance life science in Human Welfare, Alternative Energy as substitute of Hydrocarbon Energy information and Communication Technology and Mathematics- Physical Science and sports. I am proud to say that our school stood 1st in the senior

category and 3rd in Junior category and all the winners of the exhibition were felicitated for their proclivity, innovation and perfection.

As per CBSE circular, teachers of O.P. Jindal School had also played their part getting associated with the National assignment of conducting NAS (National Assessment Survey) 2021 successfully as an indispensable part of their scholastic responsibility. Encouraged by the 5th edition of PPC-2022 initiated by Hon'ble Prime Minister Narendra Modi, most of our students-parents and teachers enthusiastically took part in the unique interactive national programme in the month of December 2022.
