Academics

To reckon with, among the toppers from Class XII Science stream stand out Vaibhav Gupta (96%), Anubhav Nayak (93.4%) and Sai Sudeshna (93.2%); While in Science 7 students scored above 90%, in Commerce, 3 students stood out above 85% of marks. The highest subject score to English Core: 99, Physics:95, Chemistry:98, Maths:95, Biology:94, enumerate. Economics:95, Accountancy: 98, Business Studies: 97, Informatics:98, Physical Education:95 and Psychology:84 marks.Similarly,in AISSE Class: X exam with school average being 80.66% the top achievers from Class -X who brought laurels to the institution and were felicitated by the Chairman of the School Management Committee, Executive Director of JSP,Odisha as well as Principal of the school for their remarkable achievement in the Board Exam are Rayan Das Gupta(98.2%), Binayak Bal (97%), Ria Chaturvedi(96.2%), Somesh Nayak(96%) and others. The highest subject-wise scoring in English: 98, Maths:97, Hindi:99, Odia:95, Social Science:100, Sanskrit:100, IT:100 and Science :100 out of 100 marks.
