निःशुल्क एवं अनिवार्य बाल शिक्षा का अधिकार नियमावली-2011 के नियम 17 में उपनियम (6)
के अन्तर्गत विद्यालय की मान्यता का प्रमाण-पत्र।

महोदय/महोदया,

आपके आवेदन पत्र के क्रम में आपसे किये गये पत्राचार एवं विद्यालय के किये गये निरीक्षण के आलोक में आपके विद्यालय दून इन्टरनेशनल स्कूल, 32- कर्जन रोड, रायपुर, देहरादून को प्री-प्राइमरी से कक्षा 08 तक (अंग्रेजी माध्यम) संचालन हेतु 05 वर्षों दिनांक 07.10.2020 से 07.10.2025 तक की अवधि के लिए स्वीकृति प्रदान की जाती है। प्रदत्त स्वीकृति निम्न शर्तों के अनुपालन में अधीन होगी :-

1. मान्यता किसी भी परिस्थिति में कक्षा 08 तक की सीमा के बाहर मान्य नहीं होगी।
2. विद्यालय निःशुल्क एवं अनिवार्य बाल शिक्षा का अधिकार अधिनियम, 2009 तथा निःशुल्क एवं अनिवार्य बाल शिक्षा का अधिकार नियमावली, 2011 का अनुपालन आवश्यक रूप से सुनिश्चित करेगा।
3. विद्यालय अपनी कक्षा-1 में बच्चों के नामांकन की कुल क्षमता का 25 प्रतिशत बच्चों का नामांकन अपने पड़ोस के कमजोर एवं वंचित समुदाय के बच्चों का करेगा तथा उन्हें निःशुल्क एवं अनिवार्य प्रारम्भिक शिक्षा उसकी पूर्णता तक प्रदान करेगा, परन्तु यह कि यदि विद्यालय में पूर्व प्राथमिक कक्षाओं का संचालन हो रहा है, तो इस मानक का अनुपालन पूर्व प्राथमिक कक्षा के लिए भी किया जायेगा।
4. उपरोक्त क्रम संख्या-3 पर वर्णित बच्चों के मामले में विद्यालय को निःशुल्क एवं अनिवार्य बाल शिक्षा का अधिकार अधिनियम की धारा 12 की उपधारा (2) के आलोक में निर्धारित राशि की प्रतिपूर्ति की जाएगी। प्रतिपूर्ति की जाने वाली राशि की प्राप्ति के लिए विद्यालय अलग से बैंक खाता का संचालित करेगा।
5. संस्था/विद्यालय के द्वारा किसी प्रकार का व्यक्तिगत अनुदान/कैपिटेशन शुल्क प्राप्त नहीं किया जाएगा तथा किसी भी बच्चे की परीक्षा या उसके माता-पिता/अभिभावक का साक्षात्कार नहीं किया जाएगा।
6. विद्यालय किसी बच्चे के नामांकन से उसको आय प्रमाण पत्र, नामांकन की विस्तारित अवधि के बाद प्रवेश तथा धर्म, जाति, जन्म स्थान आदि कारणों से या इसमें से किसी एक कारण के आधार पर मना नहीं करेगा।

7. विद्यालय के द्वारा निम्न कार्य सुनिश्चित किए जाएंगे:-

- (एक) किसी भी नामांकित बच्चे को किसी भी कक्षा में रोककर नहीं रखा जाएगा और न ही किसी नामांकित बच्चे को प्रारम्भिक शिक्षा पूरी होने तक विद्यालय से निष्कासित किया जाएगा;
 - (दो) किसी भी बच्चे को किसी प्रकार का शारीरिक दंड नहीं दिया जाएगा तथा मानसिक रूप से प्रताड़ित नहीं किया जाएगा;
 - (तीन) किसी भी बच्चे को प्रारम्भिक शिक्षा पूरी करने के लिए किसी भी प्रकार की बोर्ड परीक्षा पास करने की आवश्यकता नहीं होगी;
 - (चार) प्रारम्भिक शिक्षा पूरी करने वाले प्रत्येक बच्चे को नियम 35 के उपनियम (1) के आलोक में प्रमाण पत्र प्रदान किया जाएगा;
 - (पाँच) अधिनियम के प्रावधानों के आलोक में निःशुल्क/विशेष आवश्यकता वाले बच्चों का समावेशन किया जाएगा;
 - (छ) शिक्षक, अधिनियम की धारा 24 की उपधारा (1) तथा नियमावली के नियम 31 में प्राविधानित शिक्षकों के दायित्व का निर्वाहन करेंगे; और
 - (सात) शिक्षक, निजी-स्तर पर किसी भी प्रकार की शिक्षण-गतिविधि (ट्यूशन) में संलग्न नहीं होंगे।
8. विद्यालय राज्य सरकार द्वारा निर्धारित पाठ्यचर्या एवं पाठ्यक्रम का अनुसरण करेगा।
 9. विद्यालय अधिनियम की धारा 19 के प्राविधानों के आलोक में उपलब्ध सुविधाओं के आनुपातिक रूप से छात्रों का नामांकन करेगा।
 10. विद्यालय अधिनियम की धारा 19 में उद्धृत मानकों एवं मानदंडों को बरकरार रखेगा। विद्यालय के अन्तिम निरीक्षण के समय उपलब्ध सुविधाओं का विवरण निम्नवत होगा-
