At Sunderji Early Intervention Centre (SEIC), we believe that timely, intentional, and expertly guided early intervention can transform lives. With over two decades of experience, SEIC provides individualized, empathetic, and evidence-based services designed to nurture growth in every child.

Our Interdisciplinary Team: Our dedicated team of professionals works collaboratively to create **personalized and integrated support plans** for every child. The team includes:

- **Developmental Pediatrician** Oversees developmental milestones, diagnoses, and medical guidance.
- Clinical Psychologist Conducts assessments, supports behavior modification, and provides emotional counseling.



- RCI-Registered Special Educator Designs and implements individualized education plans (IEPs) tailored to each learner's needs.
- Speech and Language Pathologist Enhances communication, comprehension, and social interaction skills.
- **Occupational Therapist** Develops fine-motor, sensory, and adaptive skills to improve daily functioning.
- **Sensory Therapist** Addresses sensory processing challenges to promote balance, focus, and comfort.
- Play Therapist Uses play to build emotional expression, creativity, and social engagement.
- **Art Therapist** Encourages self-expression, emotional regulation, and confidence through creative arts.
- **Dance Movement Therapist** Supports body awareness, coordination, and emotional wellbeing through movement and rhythm.

Together, this multidisciplinary team ensures that every child receives holistic, coordinated, and compassionate care, fostering steady growth across developmental, academic, and social-emotional domains. We do not offer isolated therapies; we create a comprehensive ecosystem of care that is responsive, reflective, and respectful of every child's individuality.

#### **Program Formats**

- 1:1 On-Site Individual Sessions Conducted in a structured, sensory-safe environment, these play-based and therapeutic sessions focus on communication, behavior, cognition, and motor development under the supervision of trained specialists.
- **Home-Bound Program** Designed for families unable to access the centre regularly, this model combines guided home intervention with periodic on-site sessions. Parents receive hands-on training to maintain structured routines aligned with the child's personalized plan.
- School Readiness Program Prepares children for formal schooling through play-based activities that develop pre-academic, social, and behavioral skills. Focus areas include early literacy and numeracy, attention building, classroom readiness, and communication confidence.



#### Where Therapeutic Excellence Meets Emotional Well-being

At Sunderji Institute of Special School, **The Nurturing Zones** bring together specialized spaces designed to support **regulation**, **communication**, **movement**, **and emotional growth**. Purpose-built and seamlessly woven into the school's daily rhythm, these zones ensure that every child's **sensory**, **physical**, **and emotional needs** are met with compassion and expertise.

- 1. The Sensory Studio: A calming, adaptive space equipped with tactile panels, light projections, swings, and soft furnishings. Each classroom also includes a portable sensory toolkit for instant regulation and refocusing.
- **2.** The Expression Hall: A mirrored, open studio where Dance Movement Therapy fosters body awareness, emotional expression, and confidence—especially for children with anxiety, ADHD, or coordination challenges.
- 3. The Sound Nest: An acoustically balanced room featuring instruments and sound-based tools for Music Therapy, promoting self-expression, communication, and emotional regulation.
- **4. The Active Zone**: An indoor—outdoor gym with fitness props, obstacle setups, and adaptive sports equipment. Enhances **strength, coordination, and teamwork** through fun, movement-based learning.
- **5. The Physio Pod**: A specialized **physiotherapy hub** (in partnership with KEM Hospital) offering structured motor and posture support using therapy balls and mobility aids in a familiar environment.
- **6.** The Digi Lab: Equipped with adaptive technology, speech-to-text tools, and educational software to build cognitive flexibility, digital literacy, and future-readiness for all learners.
- 7. The Reflection Room: A warm, inviting space for emotional safety and counseling, where students develop coping skills and emotional awareness under the guidance of trained professionals.

Established as a natural progression from the Sunderji Institute of Special School, SVI equips learners with practical vocational skills, independent living abilities, and confidence to thrive in the world of work.

#### Our Core Program: Diploma in Applied Skills & Workforce Readiness

A structured three-year vocational diploma designed for individuals with autism spectrum disorder (ASD), ADHD, Intellectual Disabilities, Down Syndrome, and Specific Learning Difficulties.

The program follows a **strength-based approach** that nurtures each learner's abilities while developing professional, social, and life skills.

## **Program Highlights:**

- Year 1 Foundation: Exploring multiple vocational pathways and building self-awareness.
- Year 2 Specialization: Advancing into a chosen skill area with applied learning and teamwork.
- **Year 3 Transition:** Real-world internships, sheltered work experiences, and job-readiness training.

- **Block Printing & Creative Design** Traditional art-based printing and small-batch production.
- **Digital Graphic Production** Design, printing, and digital workflow management.
- Creative Culinary Arts Practical cooking and baking in a sensory-safe kitchen environment.

- **Hospitality & Housekeeping** Industry-aligned training in professional hygiene and facility maintenance.
